

# NOBLES DAY CAMP

## BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT PLAN

### STEP #1

1. Quietly sit camper aside
  - a) Label the behavior
  - b) State the consequences
  - c) Give a verbal warning
  - d) Camper(s) should resume activity
  - e) Report to Head Counselors

### STEP #2 (Behavior Continues)

1. Sit camper to the side
  - a) 2 minute cool down – no talking
2. Ask questions?
  - What were you thinking/feeling when you.....?
  - What did you do?
  - What could you do next time?
    - Have camper brain storm 2 – 3 better choices to use next time.
3. Return camper to group/activity
4. Report to Head Counselor – note any patterns

### STEP #3

1. Sit camper to the side
  - a) 2 minute cool down – no talking
2. Ask questions?
  - What were you thinking/feeling when you....?
  - What did you do?
  - What could you do next time?
    - Have camper brain storm 2 – 3 better choices to use next time.
3. Sit camper out for 20 minutes
  - a) Contact Unit Leader
    - Unit Leader talks to counselor & camper
    - Depending on the seriousness of behavior, together they decide if camper should return to group
  - b) Fill out Accident/Incident Report from by Head Counselor and/or Counselor
  - c) Unit Leader & Head Counselor decide who should call the parents
  - d) Notify the Director

### ASSUMING THE BEHAVIOR CONTINUES

1. Arrange a meeting with parents, camper counselors and Leadership Team
  - a) Last step scenario (parents should have been contacted by phone 2-5 times prior to meeting)
2. Warning to stay home or
3. Camper stays home (depending on parents response)

### REFER TO STEP #3 WHEN:

1. ENDANGERS CAMPER(S)/COUNSELOR(S)
2. MALICIOUS DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY
